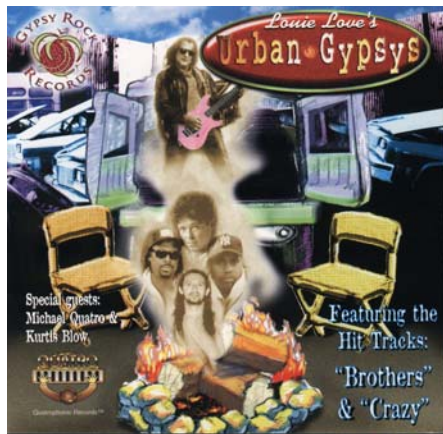

SENATOR O'BRIEN

Articulate, intense, and irreverent, Senator was born the son of a Michigan Senator—hence the given name. Having grown up the youngest of seven musical siblings surrounded by the Detroit Sound and enveloped in politics, his life experiences became the heart of his music.

In the late '80's, Senator moved to Los Angeles and formed a suave sounding band complete with horns and saxes; but the logistics of maintaining a big band sent him back to his Motor City musical roots. His new sound is called "R&B Punk," an amalgamation of melodic, but driving, high energy rock and roll, jazz elements, R&B bass, progressive guitar, and blues style vocals. Like the unusual mixture of musical styles, Senator's lyrics deal more with changing universal themes instead of exact political movements. His hit single "Whole World is Jones'n," for instance, talks about the whole world needing a fix—a reawakening of culture and spiritually based political beliefs.

Senator's current catalog includes over 400 songs and 70 full 24" reels of recorded music. He's recorded with the southern California bands "Sons of Angeline" and "Seven Hole Affair," and has worked with T Bone Burnett, Reggi Fisher, Krish Sharma and Mick Fleetwood. He has embarked on several national college tours, and has previously had top 10 college radio success with his previous single releases.
